Like you, our greatest concern is the well-being of your pet. Before putting your pet under anesthesia, we perform a full physical examination. However, many conditions, including disorders of the liver, kidneys or blood, may not be detected unless blood testing is performed. Such tests are especially important before any kind of sedation or anesthesia.

For these same reasons, we **HIGHLY** recommend blood screening before such procedures. The total cost of these tests is \$42.35. Do you request these tests to be performed?
